Dry, bright with a long lingering finish

*Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand*

Fruity, with a touch of minerality

### **Cloudy Bay**

*Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand*

Guava and citrus with a medium finish

### **The Spanish Quarter**

*Chardonnay-Abarino, Spain*

Floral with a touch of peach, long clean finish

*Merlot, Columbia Valley*

Ripe plum with a nose of dark flowers and pine

### **Avalon**

*Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley*

Deep notes of cherry with balanced oak

### **Rutherford Hill**

*Merlot, Napa Valley*

Rich with smooth tannins, touch of spice

### **Taz**

*Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara*

Light berries and currant, good acidity

### **Thomas Henry**

*Merlot, Napa Valley*

Strong and lush with plum, cherry and vanilla

### **Monticello Vineyards**

*Pinot Noir, Napa Valley*

Fuller body, elements of ripe red berries

### **Sterling (Organic)**

*Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County*

Full-flavored, long finish of dark berries and wood

### **Lyeth**

*Pinot Noir, Sonoma County*

Supple and juicy, hints of mint and blackberry

### **Stag's Leap**

*Petite Syrah, Napa Valley*

Spicy and fruity with elements of cocoa

### **Flora Springs**

*Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley*

Rich berries coupled with soft tannins

### **Louis Jadot**

*Beaujolais, Burgundy, France*

Soft yet crisp with overtones of strawberry

### **Zenato Valpolicella Ripassa**

*Veneto, Italy*

Full lush body, dried fruits with a long refreshing finish

### **Casanova di Neri**

*Brunello, Montalcino, Italy*

Hints of licourice and dark fruit, chewy finish

### **Montgras**

*Cabernet Reserve, Chile*

Medium bodied with plum and berry elements, overtones of cedar and spice

### **Tormaresca**

*Puglia, Italy*

Succulent and smooth, notes of cassis and molasses

### **Chateau Roc de Boisseaux**

*St. Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France*

Fleshy and round with a touch of spice

### **Chateau Haut-Ballet**

*Lalande de Pomerol, France*

Ripe red fruit, smooth and round

### **St. Hallet Gamekeeper's,**

*Shiraz, Australia*

Concentrated berries, beautiful long finish

### **Cote du Rhone Rouge Belleruche**

*Rhone Valley, France*

Cherry accents, licourice and spice to finish

### **Jacob's Creek Reserve**

*Shiraz, Australia*

Big and smooth with blackberry and pepper

### **Campo Viejo**

*Tempranillo, Spain*

Soft but full with dried cherries and vanilla

### **Rivola, Sardon de Duero**

*Tempranillo-Cabernet Blend, Spain*

Medium fruit with a smooth complex finish

### **Beringer**

*Chardonnay, Napa Valley*

Aromatic stone fruits and citrus notes

### **Chateau St Jean**

*Fume Blanc, Sonoma County*

Bright with honeydew and mixed citrus

### **Chateau Ste. Michelle**

*Riesling, Columbia Valley*

Clean refreshing and slightly sweet

### **Guenoc**

*Chardonnay, Lake County, California*

Softer full flavor with peach and vanilla

### **Beringer**

*Gewurztraminer, California*

Acidic, full-bodied and fruity

### **Thomas Henry**

*Chardonnay, Napa Valley*

Bright and clean with notes of apple and pear

### **Chateau Ste. Michelle**

*Sauvignon Blanc, Horse Heaven Valley, Oregon*

Crisp and fresh, finishing with grapefruit and lime
